



## **Cake Wars 2020**

Are you ready for the ultimate baking challenge?!? It's time to get creative and have some fun in the kitchen!

### **General Rules:**

- Cakes should be made and decorated by the scout, with the assistance of an adult. The purpose is family fun, not Pinterest perfect.
- Scouts must help clean up in the kitchen after they're finished baking and decorating.
- Store bought or professionally designed cakes are not permitted.
- Store bought cake mixes and icing are allowed.
- The entire cake creation must be edible. No toys, plastic cake toppers or wooden skewers for support are allowed.
- The base of every creation should be cake. The use of pancakes, cupcakes or other foods is permitted if there is a cake base.
- The cakes will not be eaten. Cakes are only judged on decorations.

### **Turn In:**

- Cakes will be turned in the Neill cafeteria before the Pack Meeting begins. Check in will start at 6:15, but please have your cake there no later than 6:30pm.
- All cakes will be given a title card with a number for judging.
- To ensure impartial judging , *scout names should not be shown on the cake or card.*

### **Awards:**

- The Pack will award a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner in 8 different categories.
- The categories are listed below. Additional categories are decided by our judges based on the types of designs that are turned in (example, if there are a lot of superhero cakes, we add a superhero category).
  - Most Original Creation
  - Tallest Cake
  - Yummiest Looking
  - Best Scout or Patriotic Theme
  - Best Camping Theme
  - Scouts Choice
- Please note that categories subject to change.
- Not all Scouts will receive a ribbon.
